THE ORGANIC ECONOMY

Then we sit back and watch the newly elected government break promise after promise, they lied, we have been taken for complete fools yet again.

We have become so conditioned to the lies, so conditioned to the same tired mantras of empty rhetoric such as 'hope' and 'change' that we bury our heads in the sand, hold our noses and carry on, let's face it, what can we do, how could we ever 'better' this system, it's ages old, tried and tested, surely there is no other way unless it is a radical shift to communism or something involving anarchy, and the vast majority certainly don't want any part of that!

After the internet had fully taken root in our lives I decided to see if there were any other people who had similar thoughts to me. I quickly learned that the internet was full of nonsense and full of the truth, one just needed to re-learn how to use discernment and critical thinking to figure out which is which.

I also learned that there are many people like myself with similar questions and many very good pundits and bloggers digging up important information that affects us all but often fails to make it into our mainstream news, therefore we are kept in the dark far more than we realise because we trust our media coverage and believe that it is comprehensive.

True journalism is one of the cornerstones of a free society, it plays a pivotal part in keeping us aware of what is happening and how our leadership is performing which enables us to have a level of control and helps keep things in check.

The mainstream media is now owned by a small group of immensely powerful people or corporations and true journalism, the kind that asks the difficult questions of our leadership has been all but eradicated leaving the alternative media as the only choice for true journalism and this is coming to light as viewing figures for television news stations and readership of print media continues to decline.

Therefore, the mainstream media are willing partners in keeping us in the dark and cheerleaders for our present political, economic and financial systems and this just further serves to cement our beliefs that there cannot possibly be another way.

In many countries governmental factions actively 'go after' anyone publishing the truth about corruption or mismanagement. Edward Snowden can attest to that.

When this happens we know that that government is abusing its power and has things to hide even though that government is paid for by the people and should ONLY be working for its people, anything else is tyranny.

These things as we all know are commonplace in third world countries but sadly they are now firmly entrenched in our own countries, none being spared.

I was always an avid newspaper reader and follower of news on the television but as I gradually came to prefer the alternative media for my news, my routines changed.

What sealed it for me was a work contract that took me away from home and out of country for three weeks and I decided not to check on any news from my home region, province and country, just to see how much news and important information I had missed. It did, to be honest, feel quite strange and I did feel I was missing something.

When I returned home absolutely nothing had changed and I realised that even something as big as a general election (a supposedly worthwhile news event) would hardly be worth learning about because, let's face it, what really changes, the same old, same old, just carries on, business as usual thank you very much!

From then on I rarely bought a newspaper and never watched the news on television. I saw it all for what it mainly is, mindless rubbish.

Once I broke away from obtaining my news from the mainstream media I found I began to research more and more things online, I began to uncover answers to my questions and a whole new world opened up to me.

I learned not to 'write off' someone because they said something I disagreed with, as most of the alternative news presenters do not follow carefully manufactured scripts but have the freedom to tell it as it is and often it is something we would prefer not to hear.

The immaculately turned out talking heads that present the news seem to give us the impression that everything they say is the truth, must be the truth, they've always told the truth haven't they? Well, no they have not. They are mere 'repeaters' and churn out whatever they are told to churn out, the news, as are most things in our lives, is controlled. We only get to hear what a certain few wishes us to hear.

From many of the websites I enjoy and resonate with I like to follow articles about our political, economic and financial systems and especially enjoy reading the comments to try and gauge the feelings of likeminded people.

People who are completely disillusioned with our systems and establishment and the gross unfairness of it all for those without the necessary money or influence to secure a privileged life.

What I learned from these comments is overwhelmingly that no one has an answer for the problems we face from our systems. It is like a mental roadblock that no-one can get past to envision a new way, a new economy that is equitable and fair to everyone, a truly humane way forward.

The best most can do is point out the wrongdoings, the corruption, the lies and deceit, but never any practical suggestion as how to really improve things for ALL of the people, except of course a violent revolution which never solves anything in the long run.

There are those who promote the peaceful type revolution of 'non-cooperation' which worked so well for Ghandi in removing British rule and that would be fine except, "Ok great, we have peacefully overthrown the government.... now what?"

No-one appears to have an answer, it is like running into a brick wall, our brains just seem to turn off at the mere thought of proposing an alternative system even though we know in our heart of hearts that so many things are just plain wrong.

The way the politicians endlessly 'stick it' to us after promising they would be the ones who would make it a fairer nation, time and time again we hear the empty promises just to be let down again. It just does not work for us, yes it works for a privileged few and quite nicely by the look of it but it does not work for the vast majority, the majority that pays the most in taxes only to be let down time after time.

I don't say these things in jealousy of what others have, I wish no-one ill will and if someone works harder or longer hours or builds a business then they certainly deserve what they earn.

This is about the gross inequities of our present systems and the way our voices are ignored and now with the 'police state' that is rapidly taking over with more and more new technologies designed to watch our every move.

Wrong, wrong, wrong! Why should we pay taxes toward our own virtual prison, to be watched and listened to even in our own homes because that is where we are heading, if we allow it.

Most people know there are many wrongs with our systems, that those we elect and pay to represent us neglect to do so in favour of looking out for the best interests of corporations, corporations in the energy, food, financial and pharmaceutical sectors among others.

Corporations that should never have access to those WE elect to serve us, there are other ways for corporations to state their cases, but they spend billions in lobbying annually, again it's all about the

money, money that buys power and privilege and tough luck on the rest of us without huge reserves of it to get our own ways to make more of it.

Corporations have grown so huge, wealthy, powerful and interconnected that the present political system is always under pressure to bow to them. These same corporations know no borders, have no affiliation to any one nation and have only one mandate, profit. The people, country, environment and resources that belong to each of us are merely expendable commodities. These very same corporations have enormous leverage over those we elect and pay to look out for us. Quite simply, we are not being represented as we should be.

One very important fact to be aware of is that the elite ultra-wealthy families that control much of the financial and corporate world have been around for a long time, many for hundreds of years. The Prime Ministers and Presidents we think of as the highest authorities in the land are merely temporary figureheads of a nation and are no match for such families, sadly, it is often these powerful families and their offshoot organizations that actually choose that leader in the first place. Our systems are far more rigged than you may ever believe and not rigged in the voters favour.

That does sound hard to believe but so does most of how things really work in our 'systems', which is why nothing will ever really improve by working within the same frameworks of our political, financial and economic systems. They simply do not serve us all fairly and never will.

The seemingly endless tentacles of the mega corporations and banking interests reach much further than most realise and are beginning to affect our lives in many more ways than before. Yes we hear about them all the time but again we tend to 'tune them out', we have busy lives, what can we really do about it all, can't someone else stand up to them and save us?

They try to sell us on globalisation and how great it will be for us all when the only benefactors are the corporations, central banks and certain elite families.

Firstly, they close our manufacturing plants and lay off hundreds of thousands of employees, to be replaced by the cheapest (almost slave) labour they can find, then tell us how great it is for us to be able to buy cheap products.

Corporations have zero allegiance to their employees in any country they happen to do business in. The executives have even convinced themselves that the only thing that matters is profit at almost any cost with complete disregard for humanity, the environment and the communities which serve them. This attitude is one of the things that 'something inside' tells me is not only wrong but unsustainable in the long run. Use all the clever words you like to convince yourself that this is just the way it is, but wrong is wrong no matter which way you cut it.

The notion of us being fortunate to have access to cheap foreign products is a fallacy. When your sons and daughters go to college or university to earn a diploma or degree where will they find employment now?

The manufacturing plants that were closed down to enable ever greater profits not only provided jobs for production line personnel but Tradespeople, Engineers, Accountants, Business graduates working in sales and marketing, Human resource personnel and the local contractors that supplied services to the plants.

Entire communities have been devastated in the name of higher profits when it wasn't necessary at all. Therefore we are experiencing a false economy, cheap goods at first then the cost to the nation of high unemployment and lower consumer spending which costs more jobs. This puts the nations finances under stress which often means higher taxes and cuts to services to try and balance the books.

We are now seeing the results of globalisation. When a nation that grew to be wealthy and powerful loses its manufacturing industries what will happen to that nation? Well, look no further than that mightiest of manufacturing powerhouses, the United States.

High unemployment, record numbers of people using food stamps, record poverty, a country that is actually bankrupt except that its currency is linked directly to oil and that is only because of the enormous military threat they are to any others brave enough or dumb enough to challenge the petro dollar (Muammar Gaddafi of Libya being one).

So what is the real cost of globalisation to the USA, cheap goods in the short term, a country in ruins in the longer term, so much for globalisation being good for everyone. It is all about one thing and one thing only, higher profits at any cost.

Do you ever find yourself thinking "How much money is enough, when does enough become pure greed?"

THE IMPORTANT ROLES PEOPLE PLAY

It has always been said that people were never forced to work for low wages and awful conditions, they knew the wage and the long hours and there was always a long line of people ready and willing to take your job if you didn't want it.

To me that sentiment is disingenuous. No matter how much money a person has, if every person alive decided never to do anything for that person then that person would have a pile of money and nothing else, no workforce, no servants, no builders, no maintenance personnel, life would be almost impossible for them to enjoy.

The point being that people need people to enjoy a good standard of living and that goes for everyone. Taking advantage of people with low pay and poor working conditions just because you can is pure exploitation but our society lauds them as good business people and that that is how you have to be to make it in business.

I disagree, from my own experiences I have seen first-hand how employees that are treated with dignity and respect will out –perform those under the ‘whip’ as they care about what they do and the quality of product that ships from the plant.

I believe that the vast majority of working people like to come home from a days work feeling they have contributed, that they feel valuable and appreciated. Yes there will always be a few who take advantage and do as little as possible for as much money as possible but to me that is as unconscionable as the rich taking advantage of their positions, both are forms of greed and destructive to humanity instead of being constructive.

We all need to be in partnership with each other, help each other, instead of the dog eat dog attitude which we are told is the only way forward if you want to get ahead in life. Get ahead to what, a bigger house, a bigger car, more and more material things which are now cheap because your neighbours have lost their jobs to globalisation, where does it all end?
Common sense tells me that this attitude has a shelf life, it cannot sustain itself indefinitely.

After the previous section about Corporations you may think I am anti-capitalist or anti-corporation but I am not.

I believe we need people with desire and drive and the will to work hard to build and grow a business and that those same people have a right to keep as much of what they earn as possible, there must always be incentives.

We have seen what happens when incentive is removed. As in the old USSR, nothing gets done and the country gradually falls apart.

The problem is when corporations become so big and powerful and use their power, influence and money to subvert our democracies for their own interests which include rolling back laws that protect workers and their rights.

Rights that were fought long and hard for because of the exploitation from the employers. Nothing has changed either for even today in our so-called civilised countries no sooner than employees lose union protection, they begin to lose their rights.

MONEY AND FINANCE

For many years I would read the newspaper or watch the Television and when it came to things like inflation, lending rates, stock markets, trade deficits etc. etc. My eyes would glaze over, in fact they still do but for a different reason today.

The first thing that would come to mind is how complex it all is, just looking at the skyscrapers the money people ply their trade in was enough to scare the pants off me. I used to think how smart these people must be and if I knew what was best for me, to leave well alone, these guys are experts and I will never understand how money works, where it comes from, and how to make money from money.

I watched the 'experts' debate back and forth about which was the best direction the country should head for job creation, prosperity and growth and how they argued their points with all sorts of numbers and statistics.

These were experts that had university degrees and years of experience and even they could not agree on which economic policies were the best way forward.

Hold it a minute! If even the so-called experts couldn't agree then who is right? It seems there are no definitive economics, it boils down to opinions and which political party is in power!

So I spent time researching and learning about how the economy works and trying to find answers for things such as why does our country have to pay billions in interest to a foreign bank when the country is hurting for services even though taxes are overbearing?

Why do I have to pay so much interest on my mortgage, why does everything go up in price, should towns amalgamate to save money and so on?

I wanted answers to my questions and explanations for why I felt so many things were just plain wrong. Over time a picture began to emerge. It became clear why we are in such a mess and culprit number one are the central banks.

Our countries un-necessarily borrow money from private banks when they could issue their own debt-free currency.

The founding Fathers of the US constitution knew this well and did what they could to stop the central bankers from controlling Americas money supply but by 1913 the US fell prey to the bankers as they weaseled their way in when the Senators should have been looking after the best interests of the people.

These same bankers were also behind the formation of the IRS, they were the ones that forced the US to tax the people on their earnings, when earnings were not supposed to be taxed as they are an honest exchange of energy, money for labour or work, a straight swap, no profit involved.

Why did Cyprus, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Portugal and Spain require bailouts from the central banks? Only recently sovereign nations, nations that are now controlled by bankers, bankers that dictate how the governments will run their countries. Bankers that demand austerity measures while paying themselves obscene salaries and bonuses.

Sovereign nations that joined a European Union only to end up in a very short time as financial and economic failures, unless of course you are the bankers.

These nations that cannot take the necessary corrective measures to improve their economies because they gave up sovereignty by opting to adopt the Euro as their currency.

They lost sovereignty because they no longer have control of their own interest rates, they are tied to whatever the European banks decides to set the rate at which can be extremely detrimental to a nations economy.

I will never forget visiting family in Ireland in 2000 and learning that Irelands economy was overheating, the Celtic Tiger roaring across the land while Germany was in a recession.

Ireland if it could, would have raised interest rates to slow borrowing and cool the economy and Germany would have lowered the rates to stimulate their economy but both were tied to the Euro and could not help themselves.

Two different countries with two different economies heading in two different directions without the power to help themselves and now look at Ireland, her younger generation emigrating again to find a hopeful future.

Whichever way you look at it, the people of these nations were improperly represented by their elected leadership. Whether that be by borrowing too much money, spending too much money or both, the so-called leadership failed the people.

And the continuous push by self-appointed experts to amalgamate everything, towns into cities and countries into unions such as the European Union and the future North American Union of Canada, the US and Mexico.

This is extremely detrimental to the people as more and more people are represented by fewer and fewer representatives.

The result being we become almost invisible and our voices are not heard, another blow to an almost non-existent democratic process.

Now we have un-elected eurocrats making laws for countries that the people had no say in whatsoever. Clearly such amalgamation leads to less say from the people and more control from the un-elected 'officials' and clearly that results in less and less democracy. Without true democracy we are at varying degrees just economic slaves.

INTEREST ON BORROWED MONEY (USURY)

People have been paying interest on loans for thousands of years and it is completely accepted as a system of finance and economics.

Why would anyone ever question usury? If you need money and someone has it to lend then they deserve to EARN a profit don't they?

Well, we are now witness to where things end up with usury.

In a relatively short time the money becomes concentrated in a few hands and these people then become extremely powerful.

"Give me the power to issue a nation's money; then I do not care who makes the law."
Mayer Amschel Bauer Rothschild.

Most people think that it's our politicians and government that is in full control of our country but sadly this is far from true.

Money and greed are human weaknesses and most of us have our price. The banking families have spent hundreds of years angling things their way so that our very own governments un-necessarily borrow from them.

There is one inherent problem with interest on money and that is it can never be fully repaid, it is a self-fulfilling prophecy that it will all collapse because there can never be enough money in circulation to repay it.

The banks lend you the principle but not the interest so where will that actually come from?

As all money in circulation is already 'debt' money (issued by banks in the form of loans) the only way to pay interest is with a growing economy, this means we need infinite growth which is impossible, it has to stop sometime and when it does the economy will collapse.

This system of finance is also what drives inflation and why the cost of goods keep rising, then we fight for more pay to be able to survive the rising costs. The entire thing is a rigged merry-go-round, or more accurately a spiral toward eventual collapse.

The real kicker is the so-called money that is lent does not actually exist, it is just numbers on computer screens. These bankers have managed to pull off THE BIGGEST SCAM IN THE HISTORY OF MANKIND!

They loan 'apparent' money to countries who then lend it to the people, who, by their honest labours, pay back principle and interest money that actually does have value!

When nations borrow money, the central bankers issue worthless 'fiat' money or 'credit', then turn on the financial and prosperity sucking vacuum cleaner and mop up the real money that people have laboured for, money with actual value.

This is why so much of our money and prosperity spirals gradually upward and into the greedy pockets of the bankers.

Absolutely brilliant, I tip my hat to the ingenuity of such a monumental scam!!

It is the same as me giving you a blank sheet of paper and you give me back a pile of money, and you keep coming back time after time to do it again, genius, total genius!

The central bankers and banking families also have their greedy hands on almost everything we buy. The interest that is paid back by manufacturers and farmers etc. is passed down to the consumer so we are always paying something to the bankers. The money gradually spirals upward into their pockets, there is hardly anything they don't have a piece of.

Your own bank is based on a pyramid scheme too. They can lend out much more (usually 9 times) than they actually have in deposits! They don't even have the money to lend you, it is all 'smoke and mirrors', just leveraged apparent money.

The world has been very cleverly manipulated into accepting all of this as 'the way it needs to be' with central bankers eventually being the sole supplier of the worlds money!

Take a minute and ask yourself how then do we pay them back? With what do we pay them back?

Well, it is our 'real' money that the people of the country earn with their labours that pays them back. So why do we not issue our own money and pay back our own country? Because our leaders over the years have been bought off, hoodwinked, blackmailed, whatever it took for them to accept this immoral system.

Canada where I live, is a stable country with huge resources and a good standard of living but has a debt (as of 2014) of over 600 Billion dollars!

According to The Canadian Debt Clock, Canadians paid 33 Billion dollars in 2007-08 just to service that debt. Currently (in 2014) each Canadian owes \$17,000 each for their share of the Canadian Government debt!

Canada will never, ever pay this off completely and this also means that our children, even grandchildren, are born into a debt they never asked for and will be paying for their entire lives should these systems continue.

I believe strongly that this should be totally illegal, it is immoral and inhumane to burden the unborn, to mortgage our children's future the way the politicians do.

“Capital must protect itself in every possible way, both by combination and legislation. Debts must be collected, mortgages foreclosed as rapidly as possible. When, through process of law, the common people lose their homes, they will become more docile and more easily governed through the strong arm of the government applied by a central power of wealth under leading financiers. These truths are well known among our principal men, who are now engaged in forming an imperialism to govern the world. By dividing the voter through the political party system, we can get them to expend their energies in fighting for questions of no importance. It is thus, by discrete action, we can secure for ourselves that which has been so well planned and so successfully accomplished.”

Montagu Norman – Governor of the Bank of England – addressing the United States Bankers’ Association, New York City, 1924

The above speech was delivered in 1924! As you can see, there is a method, a plan in the works by the bankers and the one thing that enables them the power and control they have is usury or interest on loans.

Without this they would be completely powerless.

The power of lending money to nations is all encompassing and those who cannot repay on time lose land, property and other national assets or find themselves under rule by the bankers as those in Europe are today.

Democracy ha! Sorry, that went out the window when you defaulted on your loans.

To compound matters, when things get tough and the economy takes a downturn putting pressure on the nation’s finances, the rating agencies downgrade the nation’s credit rating and the interest rate goes UP!

Pure gouging, pure greed and not an ounce of compassion.

Interest on loans is one of the main issues we have today. Extortionate credit card interest puts most people in difficulty. Yes, we have a choice not to get into debt but we are bombarded with commercials everywhere we turn, to buy this and buy that. This will make you feel good, that will make you feel loved. The pressure to purchase is always upon us today and our banks keep raising our spending limits, they do not like customers who pay on time.

Edward Bernays, a nephew of Sigmund Freud, known as the father of public relations and a pioneering propagandist said the following;

“The conscious and intelligent manipulation of the organized habits and opinions of the masses is an important element in democratic society. Those who manipulate this unseen mechanism of society constitute an invisible government which is the true ruling power of our country. ...We are governed, our minds are molded, our tastes formed, our ideas suggested, largely by men we have never heard of. This is a logical result of the way in which our democratic society is organized. Vast numbers of human beings must cooperate in this manner if they are to live together as a smoothly

functioning society. ...In almost every act of our daily lives, whether in the sphere of politics or business, in our social conduct or our ethical thinking, we are dominated by the relatively small number of persons...who understand the mental processes and social patterns of the masses. It is they who pull the wires which control the public mind."

Edward L Bernays

Basically we are all highly suggestible especially in today's age of mass media and concentrated marketing and they know well how easy it is for us to fall prey to interest payments.

Usury is the biggest problem we face in today's society.

A sovereign nation has no need to borrow from any private banker whether native or foreign to that nation.

A sovereign nation does not need to charge ANY interest on loans, now let that one sink in for a while and realise the positive consequences of that! It is completely life changing.

Once you understand how removing ALL interest changes the economy, the country, your finances and your life, you will see how it has been an un-necessary millstone around all our necks and amaze at how they managed to get our leadership to 'buy into it'.

Again, we have been so ingrained with our current systems, never really questioning them, just paying back interest like everyone else does.

"Well, it's the only way isn't it? No, it is certainly not!"

Usury is a leech on society, it drains our prosperity, the fruits of our hard work are gradually syphoned off until we wake up one day asking why the country has no money, why do we have to keep facing cuts in services, why do we keep seeing raises in taxes, why do they need to bring in new taxes on purchases and services, where did it all go so wrong?

One word, 'Usury'.

There are of course many other contributing factors but usury is the standout culprit.

There are many excellent articles on bankers and how they weaseled their way into the power they hold and on interest and usury to be found online so please research further and learn more about this subject as it has so much influence on your life.

POLITICS AND VOTER REPRESENTATION

History tells us that our governing systems gradually evolved from various beginnings to what we have today and we are told this is IT!

We in the western world now live in democracies, it is fair and just, we can vote freely for the things we want and do not want in our societies.

This is it folks, you have the very best of the best today!

So, let's take a look at the democracy we are supposed to have.

In my case living in Ontario, Canada, there are 3 main provincial (Ontario) political parties. These parties are somewhat representative of the political spectrum in most western countries, namely right wing, middle of the road to left wing and left wing.

Being someone who takes an interest, I look at what those parties are standing for and which policies they wish to implement.

I always find that I like some of the policies of each party but do not like everything each party stands for or wishes to implement should they be elected.

Therefore I am left with the quandary of choosing the party I dislike the least!

Then after winning the election, I learn that the policies I did like will NOT be implemented and that they will introduce laws and regulations I do not like and would never have voted for!

Now what sort of democracy is that? Democracy in name only.

On top of that the elected representative gives the usual speech of how humbled they are to be selected and entrusted with our faith blah, blah, blah. Then it's off to parliament or congress or senate to learn very quickly how things are actually going to happen.

Yes, our humbled representative (who may well really care at first) actually has very limited say in anything and must toe the party line.

Result for political system 1, result for real democracy 0.

Let's face it, why let an annoyance like an election disrupt the system, why interfere with a deeply entrenched 'old boy' network where the privileged few are always the winners?

Let the people vote, let them feel they are partaking in democracy. That will keep them satisfied but we know nothing really ever changes, we the privileged few win every time.

Another blow to this illusory democracy is the politically motivated media. They have NO such rights but by our complacency we the people have inadvertently allowed them to do this to us.

And if you think this will make you safer please think again.

TRUE DEMOCRACY - APPARENT DEMOCRACY - NO DEMOCRACY

In today's world you could probably break the basic levels of democracy into 2 categories.

APPARENT DEMOCRACY, which we have in most western countries. We believe we have real democracy but a little research and common sense tells you that this is not the case.

NO DEMOCRACY, this refers to the various tyrannies around the world and includes the dictators.

I couldn't include true democracy because it doesn't yet exist.

In fact we in the 'apparent democracy' group, those who actually believe we do have true democracy, will learn from some basic research that the little illusory democracy we do have is rapidly diminishing.

That bastion of freedom and democracy, the USA, even under the control of a 'democratic' political party, have all but torn up the American constitution.

The President continues to defy the very principles of the founding fathers who tried their best to guard against government tyranny by giving himself more and more executive powers which bypass the checks and balances of the elected representatives.

Then there is the NDAA. The President signed into effect, the right for the military to arrest and detain indefinitely, any American citizen, anywhere in the world without right to trial!

"I spent many years in countries where the military had the power to arrest and detain citizens without charge," writes Hedges. "I have been in some of these jails. I have friends and colleagues who have 'disappeared' into military gulags. I know the consequences of granting sweeping and unrestricted policing power to the armed forces of any nation. And while my battle may be quixotic, it is one that has to be fought if we are to have any hope of pulling this country back from corporate fascism."

The NDAA as with the Patriot Act and other security measures were adopted to deter and detain terrorists but the problem is the US government are gradually redefining what a terrorist actually is.

There is a creeping toward monitoring people who are anti-government, veterans and gun owners. They are beginning to use such terms as 'soft terrorist'.

Excuse me but being anti-government is a right of free speech, not grounds to be called a terrorist of any kind. How far will this go and where will this end?

The UK has hundreds of thousands of cameras monitoring the people and next to come is 'pre-crime' software which is supposed to know by the look on your face if you are thinking of doing something illegal. The police will then pull you in for questioning. Very much in line with the 'big brother' novel 1984 written by George Orwell.

The recent whistle blowing by Edward Snowden revealed how far the NSA, Canada's CSEC and the UK's GCHQ have infiltrated all of our lives with everything we say on the phone and write online being recorded. If we allow things to continue on this path they will be able to go back and pull anything we have said in the past and use it against us.

Edward Snowden took a huge risk and knew his life would be changed forever but he did what he felt as a US citizen he should do.

US politicians have called him a traitor, a traitor to whom? Certainly not the hundreds of millions of taxpayers that have been spied on illegally! It appears that these people forget who foots the bill, it is the people they are spying on who pay for their own incursions of privacy, their loss of rights.

More worrying is that there are some in the US government that want Snowden executed.

I never thought I would see the day when Russia would give safe haven to an American for exposing his governments illegal activities!

This all just goes to prove that an unchecked government will stop at nothing when they have free reign to do as they wish.

Remember, we are all footing the bills for this, we are paying for our own invasions of privacy, by our silence we are condoning the diminishing of our rights and freedoms, we are allowing an encroaching tyranny.

Again, all of this is available online. I am not trying to scare people but I want to explain where we are heading and what happens when we give our power away to representatives who then abuse that power.

ILLUSORY POWER

When the people fear their government, there is tyranny; when the government fears the people, there is liberty.

Thomas Jefferson

The people are not supposed to fear their government. The government in a so-called democracy is not in any way supposed to be a controller of the people. The government need be just a facilitator, a body of administrators taking care of the necessary business of enabling the smooth running of industry and commerce, the administering and distribution of funds to ensure those less fortunate are taken care of and assisted and looking after the nation and her people in general.

The people do not want or need to be 'governed' or controlled. We do not elect people to then have them control us. That would be tantamount to calling our version of democracy the right to choose which prison officer locks you up at night and watches over you.

Let's cut to the chase and understand we are all sovereign human beings, all equal regardless of which womb we originate from.

Just because some of our outdated cultures and customs espouse that some privileged people are higher up the ladder than others and that that makes them better than others is laughable today.

The divine right of Kings and their offspring has come and gone, sorry to be the one to spoil the party but we are all equal.

We are all flesh and blood, bleed the same colour and are sustained by the wonderful planet Earth. Instead of dividing and conquering, we need to work together, we are all one, let us take that to heart and begin acting that way and the nation will be as one in unison with a focus on being good stewards of the country while we are taking our turn at the helm.

We are only here for a relatively brief period in history so why not respect the land and water, the nation and our fellow brothers and sisters and try leaving a better place than that we found it to be.

In truth our governments do not have actual 'power' but they assume they do have power by default because we allow them to believe they do have power.

It is a strange unwritten rule, an unspoken subject, the systems have been around for so many generations which we are raised in and those who do question their power or authority are either silenced by the government in one way or another or shunned by the people as extremists, rocking the boat un-necessarily or just trouble makers.

Ask the government if they have power and they will tell you they are merely representing our best interests but most know this is not how it really is.

To give the illusion of power they award themselves ridiculous titles such as the 'right honourable' (British Commonwealth politicians), 'your worship' (Mayors), 'your honour' (judges). As Edward Bernays knew, we are all so highly suggestible that the mere appearance of power has an effect on us and we subconsciously believe it to be true.

I will not get into Royalty and the titled people here except to say that anyone who bows and scrapes to another is merely lowering themselves instead of showing respect to another human being and if you insist we are not all equal then you must delight in being treated as less than human because that is ALL we are, fellow human beings on planet Earth. Anything less is either self-imposed subservience or tyranny, you choose.

Again, I wish no ill will toward any human being but it is time for a new mindset of basic respect for everyone with no special cases for the privileged.

A NEW WAY, A NEW STRUCTURE

The present systems and institutions are so deeply rooted in our minds, so engrained in our psyches that we cannot see that there is another way.

Yet it is quite apparent that nothing will change by electing a different party. We have gone that route many times in the past but as we have seen, nothing really changes, at least not for the people.

Most of us are disgusted with our governments using our money to give to bankers who completely abused their positions and created financial disasters. Not only did they evade any prosecutions but sat back laughing at us knowing they are untouchable!

Then of course using OUR bailout money to lend to almost anyone but the people and to add insult to injury, also using that money for obscene bonuses! Someone pinch me and wake me up, this must be just a bad dream, it can't be real can it? Sadly, as we know, yes it is and it is just plain wrong!

This alone should be the final kick in the teeth of our present systems, they not only fail to represent us but abuse our hard earned money and set the scene for these abuses to happen again.

We are not represented. Period.

Quite simply, the entire system needs a clean sweep, a new structure based on every person having a say in how the country is run and how their lives should be. A system that serves each and every one of us as fairly, as equitable as possible.

A truly democratic way whereby WE have the power to say what we feel is right instead of giving our power away to people who fail to represent us.

A system in which WE actually represent ourselves. A system that we all partake in and can understand.

A system without politicians. There, I have said it, yes, a system without politicians!!

With the technologies and instant communication we enjoy today, politicians are now OBSOLETE! We have no further use for them.

They supposedly take our concerns to parliament, congress or senate and argue among themselves whether or not action need be taken. OBSOLETE!

Political parties supposedly standing for certain values that we can vote for are now OBSOLETE!

We have no need or use for them today. The money and time they waste bickering in ways a child should be ashamed of are over. Their time is over . We the people can take care of things now and a far better job we will do too, at least whatever happens it will be down to us as we will have voted for it.

When the people take charge of their own countries and ways of life there will be no need for politics at all, just humanity, compassion and what is best for the country and her people. Imagine that! A huge un-necessary part of our lives gone forever, politics, the game so lovingly played by those who take our money and power and hand it over to bankers and corporations that continue to squeeze us in every way they can.

IT IS TIME

It is time for the people to be aware and fully participate in theirs and their nations best interests.
It is time for the people to take back their power and right the wrongs.
It is time for true democracy, devoid of greed and self interest.
It is time for a completely new economic model.
It is time for that last final step in the evolution of democracy.
It is time for The Organic Economy.

THE ORGANIC ECONOMY

As we are so entrenched in our present political, economic and financial systems, what I am sharing with you may require a level of open mindedness and a willing to let these ideas sink in, to become familiar with and to understand the full implications of, for once you do you will see how it makes complete sense.

The irony is that our present systems are so distorted from servicing us, so unfair to the people, so undemocratic, that a truly fair and equitable system may appear radical!

What is an Organic Economy?

By organic I do not actually mean an economy based on organic foods etc. although I am a huge fan of organic foods, by organic I mean a real economy that uses real money instead of the phoney fiat 'Ponzi scheme' money or 'funny money' that almost every country in the world has been duped or strong armed into participating in by the banking families.

By organic economy I mean breaking away from a false financial system set up to benefit a very select few.

Breaking away from a system which sees the fruits of our labours drained away instead of being re-invested in our country where it so rightly belongs.

The organic economy will have no need for politicians. Every eligible voter will be required to vote by way of an encrypted message from their computers, phones or whatever devices are available to send encrypted information to a central system which will display the results after they have all been collected.

(I will elaborate later in this book).

The implications of an organic economy combined with a true democracy are enormous for the people. History will certainly be made as the first nation to implement these ideas will clearly demonstrate how a nation and her people can truly prosper, enjoy abundance and live in peace, be compassionate, less materialistic and more conscious of the environment and more in tune with nature.

As other nations follow there will be less overall control by the worlds 'leadership', the bankers and corporations, less wars and strife and more compassion and aid to our less fortunate brothers and sisters in lands and circumstances that only by pure chance we were not the ones born there. We are ALL equal on Mother Earth. There is abundance for all when the people are in control instead of a select few.

The Organic Economy will be an 'interest free' economy for all money will be loaned by that country's ONLY Bank.

There will be no reason for any of the other banks to exist unless people wish it but those private banks will not be allowed to earn interest should they lend money, for usury, the root cause of the worlds monetary woes, will be completely abolished.

Savings in the bank will not receive interest as usury is abolished. Interest only serves to compensate for inflation anyway and the organic economy will eradicate inflation.

Why should someone make money just because they have money? This is where our financial problems began, this is where greed becomes master and those with money make ever more of it, use it for nefarious purposes and we gradually slide back down the slippery slope to where we are today.

Effort, enterprise and ideas deserve reward, not just the fact you have money.

Every loan will be interest free anyway so there will be no need to fall victim to the greed of others who will take your property and possessions if you struggle to make repayments.

To eradicate inflation, the organic economy will hold ALL prices as they stand at that time. There will not be any need to raise prices on anything we buy because our buying power will never weaken. This also applies to living accommodations, houses will be the same price when your children are ready to purchase their first home twenty five years from now.

Rents will be locked in as there will be no need to raise them when inflation no longer exists.

For those who do truly increase the value of their home there will be consideration for a fair increase in value but the criteria will ALWAYS be what is best for the country and her people as opposed to pure greed.

Wages are open for discussion but as taxes will gradually go down people will have more disposable income.

The eradication of interest on all loans in the economic system will also increase spending power significantly.

In a fair and humane society the focus will gradually shift from stressful material ambition to a more relaxed lifestyle whereby the people will re-learn how to fully enjoy life with what they have and to fully appreciate family and recreation.

These presently highly stressful times will be looked back on as we now look back on serfdom and peasantry.

As things currently stand we have no idea where our economies will be in twenty years, how much will a house cost, how much will college or university tuition be? We are all at the mercy of the bankers, growth, inflation and other un-necessary nonsense.

With an organic economy we will know exactly what things will cost because we will not be economic slaves to the bankers and usury which creates these problems.

Once the country is free from paying the extortionate billions of dollars of interest to the bankers, that money will stay in the country and assist the country in its lending to the people, interest free.

Once the people are liberated from the economic slavery of the bankers and they find they have much more disposable income due to the money saved from not paying interest everywhere they turn, they will spend more into the economy creating a demand for goods and services.

In the organic economy the people will call the shots instead of politicians who cater to corporations and other countries demands or wishes.

The people can if they wish, tear up international trade deals that favour the corporations and bring back manufacturing so that they have the jobs back that were lost with the corporate globalisation scam.

A single leader such as a Prime Minister or President is weak when negotiating trade and other deals with super powers and central bankers but a nation with every voter being its leadership is a formidable force and virtually un-breakable.

The people will decide if they want the country to be part of any international or global trade deals. Anything which does not benefit the people and country can be rescinded by the people.

Credit cards will not be required as interest is abolished but the people will be issued debit/advance cards from the nations bank.

Credit will be called Advanced money, as that is what it is, an advance from future earnings.

The nations bank will take care of all loans including mortgages and car loans and also offer lines of credit or overdrought protection. The rationale being that the bank will do whatever it can to help the people as the bank is of the people.

Evictions because of non-payments of mortgages and rents will be kept to zero or the barest minimum.

The bank will do everything within fairness to keep people in their homes as this is by far the better way in the bigger picture.

Desperation and poverty can lead to crime and crime is far more expensive to society and in more ways than helping a person in hard times keep their home plus they will eventually pay back anyway, just that the people's bank will be more flexible and caring.

Specially trained councillors will be on hand to help those in financial difficulty. They will help find work and other ways to keep them from losing everything should a situation become that dire.

The days of the cold, hard nosed banking business model will be a distant memory as everyone who is employed by the bank or any other administrative department for the country will be mandated to be of service to the people and her country at all times first and foremost.

To see a person be made homeless will be akin to seeing a family member or friend being made homeless, we will all do everything we can to end the cycles of poverty, homelessness and desperation which affects us all in one way or another, often with drug and alcohol abuse and the associated crime to pay for it.

A society rife with crime and substance abuse is a sick society but this is not the fault of those who have made themselves wealthy by hard work, art or enterprise.

The problem is the systems we have now which do not work for the people.

The organic economy will address these issues as outlined here.

The term 'government' will no longer be used as will any other term such as 'authority', insinuating power and control over the people. Control over the people will not be real, implied or imagined.

This also pertains to the Police who are paid to serve and protect, the term 'force' is not necessary and will no longer be used.

The country and regions will be taken care of by administrators who will be highly trained and knowledgeable regarding their duties to the people and country.

All employees of the nation will be well versed that their main obligation is always to the people who pay their salaries and to the country.

The present departments of government will be required but will not be called 'government' departments.

All departments will be overseen by a panel of knowledgeable people who will also collect data which will always be available for the people to observe.

This data from all departments will also potentially be a part of the following years voting agenda list.

The various panels will oversee the departments to ensure everything is being done in the best interests of the country and her people. They will also be vigilant of any person or corporation attempting to buy favours or lobbying for projects which benefit themselves.

All requests from people, groups or corporations wishing to engage in any activity that may affect the people or their country in any way will have to go through the proper channels that will be in place for those purposes and the people will always have the final say.

The over-seeing panels will always have spokespeople to relay pertinent information to the people and the spokespeople will rotate so as to inhibit the image of power. We are well aware of how impressionable we are to mass media and the repeated images and words of a person.

There will be a highly qualified emergency panel in place to deal specifically with immediate matters of high national importance such as international conflicts or disasters.

However, everything they decide will be made fully public and in the shortest period will be put to an emergency vote so the people can decide how they wish their nation to proceed.

IMPORTANT HISTORICAL NOTE

The reason I stress the removal of any naming conventions for departments which pertain to any form of 'control' (government, authority, force) is this.

We are very fortunate to be around to witness the history of the USA. A country which broke away from the control of Great Britain, or more accurately, the City of London and its bankers.

The founding Fathers of the American constitution knew well the potential dangers of allowing private bankers to issue and control a nations money.

They did everything in their powers to ensure the constitution protected the American people from private bankers but even with that protection the bankers weaseled their way in illegally in 1913 and created the Federal Reserve (a group of private bankers).

At fault were the Senate who allowed this to happen. Any way you look at it, either the constitution or the representatives of the people failed them.

We are also witness today to how corrupt the American leadership is as the US is barely even attempting to hide how fascist it has become (Fascism being government run by corporations).

I don't have time to list the litany of wrongs our governments undertake on a daily basis, wrongs which do not represent the best interests of the nation and her people. But they abuse this power to the point our governments are corrupt, have sold out to other interests and are rotten to the core.

We no longer have need for them, the voter will be the only person with true power.

Therefore we can plainly see that in a new economy such as the organic economy, we must not only ensure that the bankers are abolished permanently but that the power of the country must lie totally with ALL of her people and not given away to representatives of any kind, as it is only a matter of time before they are bought off and compromised.

Most people have their price and the bankers have almost unlimited wealth to offer. So to avoid a repeat of what happened to the US we entrust the leadership of the country to EVERYONE and everyone must be as aware and educated about the nations affairs as possible. The power must always lie with the people.

END OF HISTORICAL NOTE

Every eligible voter will vote on the national agenda which will be presented every year. The voting agenda will be collated from all the main issues the various departments and the people have.

All issues will be discussed on the nations TV station and all other media so everyone knows what the main issues are and can educate themselves about them.

We will have debating teams discussing the pros and cons of any vote subject that may have deeper implications than at first thought so the people may have a maximum understanding of the issues they will be voting on.

Voting is done instantly from the peoples computers, phones or any other communicable device. The vote list may be 20 issues or 120 issues, it does not matter how many are presented and requested by the people and the departments.

Voting will be open for one week of the year and every eligible voter must vote. We must participate in the decisions which affect us all.

At present, voter turnout continues to decline or stay at undemocratically low levels. This means the people are disinterested, disillusioned or just plain fed up with the system, that is when apathy sets in and the politicians assume more power and abuse their positions with little fear of retribution. It is of the greatest importance that every eligible voter understands the issues and votes. True freedom requires self-responsibility which in this case means everyone must vote.

Parliaments, halls of congress, senates, buildings which representatives presently use for their charades will be turned over to the people to be used as forums.

The people can apply and take their turns in these public and televised forums to make their points on issues they feel strongly about.

These issues have as much chance of being on the next voting list as any other issue so this will be an important democratic forum for the people.

These ideas are just a way to get things started. Such ideas, if the people will it, may evolve into increasingly democratic systems not yet imagined, it will always be what the people will it to be through the vote.

Voting will be based on three choices; Yes, No and Uncertain.

A significant number of 'Uncertain' votes likely means the issues were not discussed or presented in a fully understandable manner. The subject can then be re-addressed, examined and debated for the following years voting list.

Voting outcomes will be enacted as soon as possible by the administrators. If something becomes unpopular then it can be rescinded at the next vote the following year.

It will be seen that after some years the vote list will become increasingly smaller as the majority of people find equilibrium in their lives and most issues taken care of.

The organic economy requires no leaders, no one person or group will have any more power or control than one single voter.

However, no matter how fair and equitable a nation becomes there will always be the few who lust for power and control.

We must ensure that the new constitution guards against this at all times.

This will entail the careful placement and rotation of national employees such as administrators to curtail any possibility of a 'power bloc' forming that may attempt a coup or to agitate the people against their own freedom and democracy. Another important reason for the people to be vigilant of the nations situations.

It only requires a short period of harder times such as a prolonged recession (should that happen) for seductive promises of jobs and more money to become attractive enough for some to protest for a new 'leadership'.

Once back in power the organic economy would soon be history and the people would very quickly once again become economic slaves to the bankers. The people must always be watchful.

Whistleblowers and those who witness actions or plans to undertake anything which is detrimental to the people and country will be allowed full freedom to express concern without punishment.

Journalism will once again be free to pursue and investigate within the laws of the land and to be the thorn in the sides of those who tend to abuse their positions.

Powerful corporations and monopolies, as with all issues, will be discussed, debated and presented for vote. This is not a manhunt for successful corporations but a fair and balanced look at whether or not the people and nation are benefitting from their presence.

The people will have full say regarding the police departments. The police work for the people and mutual respect is paramount. Policemen and women who abuse their positions will be removed. As the organic economy becomes fully appreciated there will be less and less crime, poverty and overall hardships for the populace.

Jail will be the very last resort and mainly for violent and sexual offenders that are highly likely to re-offend.

Community service and other forms of punishment and rehabilitation will be the way forward.

All positions of 'imagined' power such as Police chiefs will be subject to the scrutiny of the people. They may still be appointed by a panel of knowledgeable administrators but performance will be monitored and the local people affected may at any time call a vote to remove that chief.

Judges will be elected and accountable and the people need only refer to them as 'Sir' or 'Madam' as opposed to 'Your Honour'.

Obscene gold plated pensions and perks paid for by the people will also be available for voting on by the people. Recommendations can be made which are fair. The organic economy is not at all about anger, retribution or payback, we must leave those attitudes behind us along with the greed so prevalent in today's broken systems.

Civil servants or national/provincial employees will not be attracted to those positions because of high salaries, jobs for life and higher than average pensions but because they actually want to help and serve their country and people.

Gradually, all people will be able to enjoy retirement with dignity as the country prospers with an organic economy.

The military will be required until most of the world adopts the organic economy but for defensive purposes only.

The military will no longer assist certain nations who use their militaries as policemen for corporations that raid other nations assets.

As the country becomes increasingly prosperous taxes will gradually go down leaving the people with more and more disposable income to spend.

This will also lead to lower and lower tuition fees for college and university students until it will eventually become free.

Meanwhile there will be no interest on current loans.

New courses and degrees will be available that deal with national administration positions, again with the emphasis on what is best for the people and her country. Eventually the country will be administered by very competent, fair and balanced employees with all our best interests at heart.

School curriculums will be adapted to reflect the organic economy. Students will be required to learn the basics such as reading, writing and arithmetic, cursive writing and the 'times tables' but also encouraged to think critically.

They will also spend as much time as possible outside exploring nature and learning about the environment and be encouraged some of the time to elect among themselves that which they wish to learn that day.

All natural talents will be encouraged and teachers will assist in exploring as many creative ideas as possible.

At the beginning of the organic economy era there will be many 'teething problems' but the next generation who will be well versed with it will grow into adults who only know of a system of equity for all, whereby no one person or group has power over others and that generation will never go back to the awful old system of politics, old boy networks and all the other systems of suppressing the people that exist today.

Those who wish to become teachers may stay in their respective schools for a period of time (2 years for example) as paid mentors and tutors, to help the children and be with them to ensure their well being and be observant toward negative behaviour such as bullying and then working to eradicate it. This will help the school staff and give valuable practical experience to the teacher student in preparation for University.

SMALLER COMMUNITIES

I discussed earlier the problems with amalgamation and how it eliminates democracy in all but name. How the European Union is ordering once sovereign nations to what they can and can't do and how unelected eurocrats are making thousands of laws for people who never voted for those laws. The big losers are the people and democracy.

The only way for people to have control over their day to day lives is to return back to community living. Keeping communities in control over their own affairs, affairs that are specific to that community.

The present system of local representatives or councillors, in most cases, works for the people because they are community focused and the councillor lives among the same voters and is fully aware of the local concerns.

But there is certainly room for improvement and the locals can use the same voting system each year to address local issues. Therefore the councillors again would be more like administrators ensuring the will of the people is undertaken or enacted.

The annual voting system will eliminate any need for time wasting politics and theatrics and we can observe with great interest as to how things evolve through the will of the people.

Local issues such as new housing developments on land considered precious by the local people and other similar issues whereby the local people feel they are being 'steam rolled' by a corporate power, will be completely in the hands of those voters affected and they will have the final say. Again, the defining principle being what is best for the people and the land.

A NEW CONSTITUTION

A country that adopts the organic economy will also need a new or modified constitution, a document that all the people agree is valid and will be the template compass for the nation to follow.

The main points for an organic economy are as follows;

To enshrine that the people's bank and only that bank will issue debt free, interest free money.

To eliminate politics – politicians are obsolete – annual voting by the people will replace them.

To eliminate usury in all forms – no more borrowing from central bankers – no more interest on any loans

To cap ALL sales prices – inflation to be eliminated.

To ensure that no person, group or entity has any more power than any singular person.

To ensure that all national matters are made public as soon as possible.

To enshrine that what is best for the people and their country, their land, their water, is the basis for all decisions.

To ensure that the less fortunate are helped as much as possible with every possible effort being made to help them lead productive lives.

To reduce or eliminate tuition fees for college and university students.

There will be many more items to be added but these are the most important I can think of now.

As with anything that affects the people and her country, everything will be voted on and agreed to by the people. Additions and amendments can be proposed, presented and debated as with all issues affecting the people.

QUESTIONS AND POTENTIAL ANSWERS

This is a most interesting section of this book. I have written this mainly with my own thoughts and therefore have not addressed any concerns or questions raised about the organic economy (yet).

The one person whom I began to explain it immediately shook their head and said “Nope, can never happen”.

This is exactly what I expect to hear from most people because, as I said earlier, we are so entrenched and so indoctrinated into our current systems that it is, for many people, almost impossible to think ‘outside the box’, to peek through veil so to speak, and see what lay on the other side.

This is mainly due to our beliefs. Our beliefs ‘filter’ our perceptions and are the gate keeper of what we think is possible.

Most of our cultural and customary beliefs are cemented into our psyches in the first seven years of our lives and this also includes our ‘systems’ and institutions, our ways of life that we learn from our parents, then teachers and so on.

These beliefs are all but hard coded into our psyches and anything that questions or threatens those beliefs can often be treated with hostility in its defense, such is the power of entrenched beliefs.

As I said earlier, when an accepted system is so distorted from servicing us, so unfair to the people, so undemocratic, that a truly fair and equitable system may appear radical!

Even if a new system is fair, it may be deemed radical or impossible because our present beliefs will not allow those thoughts to enter the mind.

However, an idea whose time has come is immensely powerful.

Few would have ever thought that Gandhi could have achieved that which he did. The Indian people would never have thought they had the potential ‘power’ to remove the British Raj in any way, shape or form, but to do it with non-violence, with non-compliance, now that would seem impossible, but do it they did!

An idea whose time had come was spread by one man. The time had come, beliefs were changed, the mental barriers which guard the mind fell away and the people saw a new vision, a new way forward and nothing could stop that vision, such is the power of the people, people who have opened their minds and discarded the old beliefs.

What was the biggest difference that people such as Gandhi, Martin Luther King, Nelson Mandela and the other brave souls who have made history by standing up to governments and militaries made? Answer, they changed people’s beliefs. Then history was changed. These people inspired the masses in such a way that their beliefs were changed and nothing could stop that power.

When your beliefs are changed (with regard to governments) you will naturally find that you will ‘lower the bar’ mentally to what you will accept and as you lower your own bar, the government

simultaneously loses power because the only power they actually have is the power we think or imagine they have.

When a critical mass of people change their beliefs and cease to accept the government as a power, the government will cease to be a government.

This is where we are today. We know things are so wrong and we merely need to change our beliefs that we can live in peace, harmony and abundance. It is up to us, period!

I will also say unequivocally that the global power brokers, the controlling bankers and corporations will understand exactly what I am saying. They know this is true and completely rely on the 'built-in' mental barriers we are all victim to.

It is the only way they can successfully maintain their despotic grip on us. The mental prison we unknowingly live within.

We are taught in schools how to think and critical thinking has no part in our curriculum. This is intentional as the industrialists insisted on workers who were educated enough to communicate and operate machinery but not to ask 'difficult' questions such as I have done in this book.

There is nothing quite as powerful as thought and the powers that be are well aware of this. When the people change their beliefs and thoughts there is nothing a government can do to hold it back. There is no need for revolution, merely evolution, evolution of thought, evolution of beliefs, evolution of democracy.

So, I say to you the reader, if you find yourself putting up barriers to these ideas, to the organic economy, then please ask yourself which beliefs are behind those thoughts, try to identify their source and see what you discover.

Q – The government will not simply roll over and let this happen, how can this be achieved?

A – I agree, at present no-one with privilege and 'apparent' power will be willing to step down for the organic economy to commence.

It will most likely be a replacement for a collapsed system caused by anything from a natural disaster, global pandemic or war to a financial collapse which is looking ever more likely to happen in the near future.

The people can then pick up the pieces and start anew. The most important thing I believe is that we actually have a blueprint for a new system and this is why I am writing about an organic economy. Without a new idea we would merely rebuild using the only blueprint we know, namely, our present systems.

Q – What will happen to those currently in positions of 'power' and privilege such as politicians and senators?

A – Always keep in mind that these same people are also products of the same systems as we are, even though many have had privileged upbringings and lives and many have abused their positions it is time to start anew.

The organic economy will not be concentrating on the negative emotions, looking for revenge and punishments unless the people decide that certain people need be punished. It will be time to move forward in a positive manner looking to build bridges, to be inclusive instead of divisive.

I also offer that most of us in similar positions would find the human weakness for greed challenging to deny.

I believe the fault lay mainly with the 'systems' and that in today's powerful global interactions that too much power is in the hands of too few people.

The organic economy solves that issue as it will be the people who make the decisions.

I would suggest that those ex-politicians who display a true passion for the country and her people would also be a valuable asset bringing extensive experience to our over-seeing panels and stewards of democracy.

There is nothing to fear for those who want what is best for all the people.

Q – The powers that be, central bankers and corporations will never let this happen!

A – Again, this is a belief from our present paradigm.

Of course the central bankers will do everything they can to impede the progress toward true democracy and economic freedom, to maintain and continue their parasitical systems of usury over the people but they will be no match for the people, people with a new belief.

The nation will assemble the very best lawyers who will show clearly that we have all been duped by an ages old farcical system of usury.

They will state the case that no country has the right to borrow upon the backs of the unborn, natural law would not allow that.

All laws can potentially be revisited by the people for vote and if need be, they can vote down anything that ties their country to any form of deal that is a proven detriment to the country or her people.

Everything that happens to the country including threats from the world's leaders and bankers will be broadcast for the world to see.

The world will have a front row view of those who threaten in the name of greed and control.

People around the globe are already aware and angry about these things and in time, one by one, other nations will also demand an organic economy.

Q – Politically speaking, is the organic economy a socialist system?

A – No, as there are no politicians and everything is voted on by all the people it is an inclusive, apolitical, democratic, humanitarian system.

Being inclusive means everyone, which means taking care of the less fortunate, those in need and those who fall on hard times, to those who are enterprising, build businesses and employ people, we will all enjoy the freedom to pursue our own destiny without 'labels'.

If you wish, you could say there is socialism and capitalism, both are necessary in a successful and prosperous country but these two labels have been at each others throats for many years un-necessarily. Politicians have had great careers on the back of these labels and it gets us nowhere in the end.

However, there needs to be balance and the people will keep corporate power in check as well as wasted administrative spending.

Q – Is the organic economy about the redistribution of wealth with the rich being taxed heavily to subsidise the poor?

A – No, I believe there is confusion over the rich versus poor issue. We do not usually complain when a famous artist such as a singer, actor or musician makes untold millions of dollars but when a business person does they are often thought of as greedy and callous.

Even if the rich were taxed at 99% (which the UK actually did at one time) this would not eliminate poverty but would destroy incentive.

When the issue of poverty is mentioned it is common practice to look straight at the wealthy but it is not the fault of the wealthy. Yes they can be exploitive and callous but they need not shoulder all the blame. The issue is really with our current financial systems of usury which drain our prosperity leaving little left for the less fortunate. The colossal impact of interest on loans is such that it eventually ruins a nation. With the abolishment of usury there will be enough money and resources to take care of the less fortunate.

Q – You stated that there would be no inflation. How does that affect the value of our money, and how will it affect our imports and exports?

A – When a currency is tied to a set value such as a certain amount of Gold and inflation is kept at zero, the currency will never de-value. Then as other currencies that remain within the present system experience inflation, their currency devalues against our currency.

Even as other nations raise their prices because of inflation, this will have a zero net effect for us as our currency will always be stronger and enjoy increased buying power.

Therefore, the cost of imports and imported raw materials will not be affected but exports will be affected as they will be more expensive for other nations to buy due to our stronger currency.

This can be addressed with subsidies from the nations bank to allow our exporters to compete.

The globalists have disdain for subsidies but the people will no longer be held hostage by special interests, especially those of foreign corporations.

Q – I have a good life, my wife and I both have good jobs that we enjoy, we have a nice house, two cars and take vacations each year. The organic economy sounds good but how will it affect our lives, we don't really want to lose the lifestyle we have?

A – Nothing that affects what you already have. You will have your jobs, cars and house and still take your annual vacations but you will find as interest on loans (usury) is eliminated, you will enjoy more disposable income.

Then as the nation grows in true prosperity and taxes are gradually lowered you will enjoy further increases in disposable income.

You will also enjoy increased spending power when you holiday 'out of country' as your currency gradually grows in strength against other currencies.

You will be expected to vote each year on the issues presented by the people and the nations employees as everyone will be mandated to do so. The success of an organic economy and true democracy depends upon your annual vote.

Keep in mind also that the present systems are going to collapse one way or another anyway, it's just a matter of time.

Q – I own a small business and employ 5 people, I have worked extremely hard to grow this business and want to know how the organic economy will affect me?

A – As a business owner nothing will change except the administrators will be looking at all of the 'red tape' and cumbersome government agencies which cause so much grief for businesses, with the idea of streamlining to make things as easy as possible for the business owner.

As with everything else that concerns the people and the nation, suggestions for improvements can be presented, discussed, debated and added to the vote list to be ratified by the people.

One big difference will be the removal of usury or interest on any business loans. This will enable a business owner to reduce prices to the customer or increase wages for example.

Q – Many people are concerned about the effects on the environment from projects such as the Tar sands and the oil and gas pipelines, what will happen to them?

A – As with any decisions it will be up to the people to decide. However, all details must be discussed such as the cost of fuel if the Tar sands were stopped and other residual effects that may at not first be apparent to everyone.

Every effort must be made to fully disclose any and all information and the possible outcomes of terminating such projects so the people make informed decisions.

The new economy however, will provide research and development funds for alternative energy sources.

Q – How long will it take to implement the organic economy, it can't just happen overnight?

A – Any new system will have teething problems and there will be a huge learning curve as this will be something that has never been done before in a developed society.

We have been subjected to so many methods of control over the past thousand years and longer that even if takes ten to fifteen years before economic equilibrium is achieved, it will be worth waiting for.

However, I believe we will enjoy marked improvements in our lives within 5 years and equilibrium within 10 years.

Q - What do people have to do to make the organic economy happen.

Do we organise, protest, march and rally because most people won't do that and it usually fails to change anything anyway?

A - The most important action to take is to spread the idea as far and wide as possible as it applies to all of the world's population.

I believe firstly that it is extremely important that people realise there is another way so we can rebuild using a blueprint such as the organic economy after an economic or financial collapse.

What is important to note is the next generation, in 10 years, will already be free thinking and rid of the mental shackles of today's systems. They will only know one way of living and the organic economy will be all they know. They will not want any part of systems such as those we live under today.
